Document preparation:

1. A passport photo (1.5 × 2 inches)
2. Birth certificate
3. Payment record or bank slip for application fee \$40.00
 - Please keep the original copy of the bank slip for checking purpose
 - Please write the applicant name and birth certificate number on the payment record or bank slip
 - The application fee is non-refundable

(All uploaded documents are required to be readable and passport photo must be clearly in focus showing the applicant's face. Applicants with unclear photos / documents will not be considered.)

Return method:

Submit the application form in person (together with the required documents)

Interview Arrangements

1. The kindergarten will arrange an interview for all applicants.
2. Interviews will be conducted on 11th November 2021 (Thursday). If the number of applicants exceeds expectations, interviews will be continued on 12th November 2021 (Friday). Please note that the date and time of the interview cannot be rescheduled.
3. Individual interviews will be arranged.
4. Cantonese will be the main language used in our school, the interview will be conducted in Cantonese. When interviewing NCS children, interpretation and / or translation service for applicants will be provided where necessary to facilitate communication.

Announcement of Admission Results

1. For online application, we will inform parents of the K1 admission results through email on Tuesday, 14th December, 2021.
2. On 14th December 2021, our school will also announce the admission results through our website at 4pm.
3. Unsuccessful applicants: If parents would like our school to put the candidates on the waiting list, please download the form from the school website or obtain from school in person. Completed form can be submitted by fax(2475 8718) or in person during office hours.

Admission Criteria

1. Age of admission to K1 class need to be over 2 years 8 months on or before August 2022.
2. Interview performance.
3. The applicant with parents currently working in the kindergarten will be given due priority consideration.
4. The applicant with sibling(s) currently studying in the kindergarten will be given due priority consideration.
5. The applicant with parents or sibling(s) previously attended in the kindergarten will be given due priority consideration.
6. The applicant with parents currently in the kindergarten management committee will be given due priority consideration.
7. Church member of Yuen Long Church (Church of Christ in China) will be given due priority consideration.
8. The same religion.
9. Living nearby.

(As the number of school places is limited, please understand that not all applicants fulfilling the priority consideration will be guaranteed a school place.)

Registration Arrangements

1. Successful applicants: Parents should complete the registration procedures for their child from 6 to 8 January 2022 (“Centralised Registration Dates”) by submitting the “Registration Certificate for Kindergarten Admission” (hereafter referred to as “RC”) / “AP” to the kindergarten and paying the registration fee \$970.
2. Please be reminded that if parents cannot submit the “RC” / “AP” during registration, the kindergarten may not be able to complete registration for their child. Hence, parents are required to submit application for the registration document to EDB within the specified period.
3. The registration fee for 2022/23 K1 place is HK\$970. If the child concerned studies in the kindergarten, the registration fee paid will be refunded in September 2022. Should parents decide to change school after registration, please notify the kindergarten in writing. The kindergarten will return the “RC” / “AP” as soon as possible but the registration fee will not be refunded. Upon obtaining the “RC” / “AP”, the kindergarten will no longer keep the school place for the child.

***Application for the “Registration Certificate for Kindergarten Admission”**

1. Under the kindergarten education scheme (Scheme), each child who can receive education in Hong Kong will only be issued a registration document and all Scheme-KGs can only admit students holding a valid registration document.
2. Parents are required to submit an application for the “Registration Certificate for Kindergarten Admission” (hereafter referred to as “RC”) to EDB **from September to November 2021**. The “RC” will be open for applications in September 2021 and EDB will announce and upload the details of application onto EDB’s website (https://www.edb.gov.hk/k1-admission_e) in due course. Upon receipt of the applications with all necessary information and documents provided, EDB will generally take six to eight weeks to complete processing of the applications and issue the “RC” to applicants who are eligible for receiving subsidy under the Scheme by post. If a child cannot obtain an “RC” as he/she can receive education in Hong Kong but is not eligible for receiving subsidy under the Scheme¹, EDB will then issue a “Kindergarten Admission Pass” (hereafter referred to as “AP”) to the student concerned for registration and admission to a Scheme-KG but the parents concerned are required to pay full school fees before deduction of subsidy under the Scheme as shown on the Fees Certificate of the KG to which the child is admitted.
